RELEASE PAPER

2742 High Density Two-Sided Release Paper 105' x 42"

- Completely coated with non-stick Silicone on both sides
- 3.5 mil thick
- Completely protecting your art and platen from adhesive
- Use at 300°-350° in a roller press, (do not exceed 235° in all other framing equipment)
- Recommended for use as a cover sheet to protect artwork and presses from any overhang to transfer of adhesive
- Release paper can also be used as a release folder, and can be used repeatedly

DIRECTIONS FOR RELEASE PAPER USE

- 1. Cut two sheets of release paper larger than the work to be processed. When using a mechanical press cut the release paper to the size of the press.
- 2. Place one sheet of release paper on the top and one on the bottom of the materials before processing.
- 3. After processing in the press, remove all the materials and the release paper. Cool under weight if necessary.

Release Folder Use

- 1. Cut one sheet of release paper twice as large as the work to be processed. When using a mechanical press cut the sheet twice the size of the press being used. Fold the release paper in half to make a release folder.
- 2. Place the materials inside the release folder before processing.
- 3. After processing in the press, remove all the materials and the release folder. Cool under weight if necessary.
